Dear Congressman Paul:

On behalf of U.S. Border Control and its thousands of supporters, I want to thank you for your leadership in a number of areas that will make our borders more secure and help put an end to illegal immigration.

Your strong efforts to deny taxpayer funds to illegal immigrants is a common-sense approach that will help discourage illegal immigrants from even coming to the United States. We at US Border Control, also were strong supporters of your amendment to the Homeland Security bill to restrict visas from students from terror supporting countries. You are one of the few who have demonstrated an understanding that immigration is a key component of Homeland Security.

Your introduction of a constitutional amendment to deny automatic citizenship to those born who happen to be born in the U.S. but whose parents are not citizens is also to be commended. This loophole has permitted an onslaught of immigrants into the U.S.

Your opposition to allowing Social Security to illegal immigrants and your opposition to any "totalization agreements" with Mexico that would allow such payments should be supported by all seniors on Social Security and anyone who does not want to subsidize illegal immigration. Social Security for illegals simply amounts to yet another incentive for people to come to the U.S. to receive a government check.

Finally, we strongly support your continued commitment to oppose any form of amnesty for those in the country illegally. We are pleased that you have taken this brave stand along with other fellow members of the Immigration Reform Caucus.
